5 Ways to Freshen Up Your Home

Getting tired of your house? There are ways to freshen up your home's appearance without spending much at all. Try these low-cost ideas to make over the room whose sameness annoys you most:

1. Scrub everything that will hold still. First, store or give away any items with no sentimental value. Wash walls and window coverings, deep-clean rugs, and install brighter light bulbs. Right away, everything will look newer and more interesting. Budget: \$35 for lights and cleaning supplies; \$25 to rent a carpet cleaner.



- **2. Rearrange the furniture.** Simply changing around the tables, couch, and chairs can be a real mood-brightener. You might exchange some furniture with a different room. Try swapping wall décor, too. Or look for inexpensive artwork in a secondhand store unlike anything you've ever bought before. Budget: \$20 to \$30.
- **3. Try different tricks that delight the eye.** Replace old throw cushions with a scattering of bright new ones from a discount store. Budget: \$75 or less for cushions.
- **4. Paint the walls a completely different color.** Start by buying several tester-size cans of different hues. Daub patches on the walls, then live with them for a few days under various light conditions. Budget: About \$4 per tester can; \$100-\$200 for enough paint to cover the room.
- **5. Replace one piece of furniture.** A lamp perhaps, or a chair or rug. Instead of buying new, see if you can find something suitable in storage or in a thrift store that might only need cleaning, refinishing, or reupholstering. Rehab it so that it becomes the new focus of the room. Budget: Under \$100.
